Subject : REACH regulation – (EC) 1907/2006, Information to the update of the SVHC Candidate list from January 17th, 2023

Dear Customer,

With regard to the latest update of the SVHC Candidate list on January 17th, 2023 we would like to inform you on NEVEON Poland Sp. z o.o. status and its ongoing activities in respect of the applicable European Chemical legislation.

As you know, NEVEON Poland Sp. z o.o. itself is considered as a downstream user (i.e. a producer of Polyurethane Articles) and in consequence does not fall under the obligation of registration which is an obligation for our suppliers. Nevertheless, NEVEON Poland Sp. z o.o. is regularly communicating with its suppliers and follows all relevant discussions within ECHA to ensure that NEVEON Poland Sp. z o.o. would only use REACH compliant products for its business activities.

In the latest update of the SVHC candidate list on January 17th, 2023, among other substances Melamine (CAS 108-78-1) has been defined new as SVHC substance. Based on this information available to us, we can inform you that the articles supplied to you by NEVEON Poland Sp. z o.o. do not contain any of the SVHC's as listed until today in the Candidate List above a limit of 0,1 % (w/w), except that some of our products are containing Melamine in a concentration above 0,1 % (w/w).

If your products are affected, you will be informed in a separate letter with reference to Article 33 (1) REACH about the Safe use of Melamine. NEVEON Poland Sp. z o.o. will also submit a notification in the ECHA SCIP database according the Waste Framework Directive about our articles containing Melamine in a concentration above 0,1% (w/w).

For the articles and packaging materials purchased by NEVEON Poland Sp. z o.o. as of today, none of the suppliers of these articles has announced that its products contain SVHC ingredients or SVHC's above 0,1 % (w/w).

We can also confirm that our products are not subject to the restrictions of Article 67 in conjunction with Annex XVII and do not contain any substances that are subject to authorization and are listed in Annex XIV.

NEVEON Poland Sp. z o.o. will continue to use all reasonable efforts to comply with its obligations under REACH in order to continue the production and supply of your products.
